MEMORIES OF OUR TRIP TO NIAGARA FALLS
NOVEMBER 25-26 1961

My husband to be was a fourth year seminary student in St. Paul, Minnesota. We had chosen Thanksgiving weekend in November 1961 to be married in my home church in Grosse Pointe Woods, Michigan. It was semester break for him, so we planned our special day for the Friday after Thanksgiving. This would give us a "short" honeymoon.
